

- 9.2 The share of the circular economy is increasing in the total volume of material flows (SDG 12)








Landfill-dominated Czechia

Municipal waste management in the Czech Republic in 2020


Waste hierarchy according to the Waste Act

Material use (includes reuse and recycling)


Energy recovery

(landfilled waste in tonnes per year)




Kryblice landfill (Turnov): 2006 vs. 2021





Not Achieving the European Target for Reduction of Landfilling of Biodegradable Waste



Low Landfill Fee and No Charged Hazardous Waste

Basic landfill fee: € 20 per tonne of municipal waste

Incomes for municipalities


Price of waste-to-energy recovery (2021): € 70 per tonne

Extra risk charge: € 185 per tonne of hazardous waste

Incomes for State Environmental Fund

€ 2,99 million (2018 – 2020)


